Mission Statement

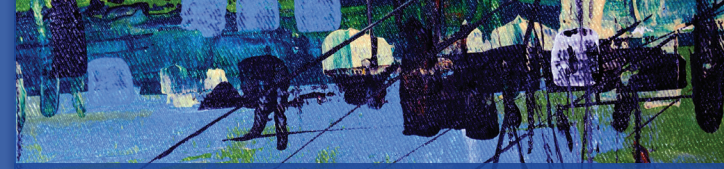

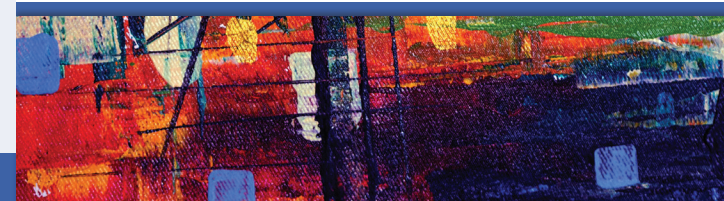
